The Senior Engineer, Oilsands Development will manage projects from conception to commissioning by collaborating and coordinating internal and external resources.

Key Responsibilities:

- Collaborate with Subsurface, Engineering, Operations, and Integrated Corporate Teams to prepare and maintain the BlackGold development plan.
- Coordinate the preparation of project scope and business case review document(s) for proposed projects;
- Organize and chair regular development meetings with the cross functional team to ensure combined communication on development plan objectives and schedule;
- Work closely with corporate business planning to build out development scenarios, conduct economic evaluations and maintain the corporate economic model;
- Collaborate with the subsurface team to define and assess well pad development strategy;
- Prepare and maintain integrated development schedules for major capital projects, pad development and facility expansion;
- Work closely with Procurement Management to ensure strategic selection of vendors and suppliers;
- Develop pad and infrastructure detailed designs with internal and external support;
- Manage engineering, EPC, consulting firms, and other external resources as required to conduct feasibility studies, DBM, FEED, detailed engineering, and construction projects;
- Prepare and own project AFE's;
- Manage all aspects of the electrical, civil, mechanical, and process design through external contract engineers, EPC, or in house;
- Coordinate internal and external resources as required to prepare all regulatory applications, audit material, and secure permits including ABSA, AER, and municipal development permits as required;
- Coordination of key meetings or review points: scope, engineering, controls, HAZOP, construction, kick-off, commissioning and start-up support etc.;
- Build collaborative and respectful cross-departmental relationships;
- Provide visible leadership of Harvest's safety values and policies with staff, vendors and suppliers; and
- Other duties may apply.

Qualifications:

- Minimum 10 years progressive Oil & Gas industry experience; significant in-situ oil sands experience is a must.
- Well rounded oil sands experience including facilities or process engineering, production, project commissioning, start-up and operations support roles. Experience with drilling, completions and seismic acquisition would be an asset.
- Professional Engineer with applicable education (Mechanical, Chemical, Civil, Petroleum Engineering) and Professional designation with APEGA.
- Previous experience on projects exceeding \$50MM.
