The Senior Facilities Engineer will provide day to day support to the Operations Team, lead optimization initiatives, provide process integrity leadership, and manage capital improvement projects (MOC).

Key Responsibilities:

- Work with field operations, maintenance, and technical staff to resolve operational issues related to facility safety, performance, and reliability;
- Collaborate with operations and engineering teams to drive production capacity to achieve stretch targets;
- Provide operating cost management leadership through facility performance benchmarking and KPI measurement and tracking;
- Provide stewardship of the BlackGold mechanical integrity programs;
- Identify, assess, and implement facility optimization opportunities;
- Facilitate the MOC process from initiation to implementation;
- Manage capital improvement projects from engineering through to operations;
- Provide mentorship to engineers on the Operations Engineering Team;
- Coordinate the preparation of project scope and business case review document(s) for proposed projects;
- Organize and chair regular engineering meetings with the cross functional team to ensure combined communication on project performance, capital project objectives, and related schedule;
- Work closely with Procurement Management to ensure strategic selection of vendors and suppliers;
- Manage third party vendors and services to deliver projects on time and on budget;
- Prepare and own project AFE's;
- Build collaborative and respectful cross-departmental relationships;
- Provide visible leadership of Harvest's safety values and policies with staff, vendors and suppliers; and

- Minimum 10 years progressive experience in thermal in-situ facility engineering and operations.
